2024 Spring Performance Trip - Hawaii

We are excited to share that our Murrieta Valley High School Crimson Cadets have been nominated and selected to officially represent the entire state of California in the **2024 National Vietnam Veterans Day Parade in Honolulu, Hawaii!** The ensemble will travel between the dates of **Monday, March 25th and Saturday, March 30th**, with the parade occurring on Friday, March 29th.

Please complete this form to register your student and any additional family members (either parents/guardians or siblings) who wish to participate in this excursion. Also, we ask that you indicate what financial contribution your family can make towards the trip on behalf your student. The information provided will be kept confidential, and it will only be used to determine if the entire band will be able to commit to a trip of this size and how much additional funding the MVHS Band Program and the Nighthawk Marching Band Boosters will need to raise in order for the excursion to occur. **Final approval of this trip is contingent on (1) all pledge payments being submitted on time and in full according to the Payment Schedule listed below and (2) the Director of Bands and Executive Officers of the Nighthawk Marching Band Boosters determining that the additional funds needed for the excursion can be successfully raised. If the above conditions are not met at any time prior to the completion of this trip and the excursion must be cancelled, partial refunds will be given based on the trip cancellation's number of days prior to departure in accordance with our respective travel agency's Refund Policy.** Please feel free to contact me at bpulverenti@murrieta.k12.ca.us if you have any questions.

Eligible Participants:

- All members of the Murrieta Valley High School Crimson Cadets
 - Optional trip for all marching band members
 - Must maintain a 2.0 Academic Grade Point Average throughout the 2023 – 2024 school year
 - Must remain enrolled in the Marching Band class and respective concert ensemble/Color Guard class for the duration of the school year
- Current Seniors (Class of 2023) members who wish to come back and perform with the ensemble
- All incoming Freshman (current 8th Grade) members of the MVHS Crimson Cadets
- All associated family members (parents/guardians and siblings)
 - Siblings must be accompanied by a parent/guardian

Pricing:

The cost to attend this trip is \$2,400.00 per person for a quad occupancy room. Those who wish to stay in a room with less than four total people must pay a supplement charge in addition to the trip's base cost of \$2400.00. Please see below for the Room Supplemental Charges chart:

- Triple occupancy – 3/room: additional \$115 per person
- Double occupancy – 2/room: additional \$325 per person
- Single occupancy – 1/room: additional \$950 per person

\$500 (final payment) due on December 29th, 2023 – those opting for a single, double, or triple occupancy room must also pay their Room Supplement Charges in full by this date
